

- Park the machine on a level surface, and raise the plow a few centimeters (inches) off the ground.
- 2. Place a jack stand under the plow pushframe, shut off the vehicle engine, engage the parking brake, and remove the key.
- Remove the 2 outermost bolts, 2 washers, and 2 nuts securing the blade to the plow and discard them (Figure 1).


Safety

Installing this kit will change the weight of your plow. Ensure that your vehicle does not exceed the gross-vehicle-weight rating (GVWR) at any time. You may need to weigh the vehicle and add ballast or limit the payload of the vehicle to compensate.




- 1. Discard these fasteners.
- 4. Use the table below to determine which holes in the curb guard (Figure 2) to mount the guard through.
